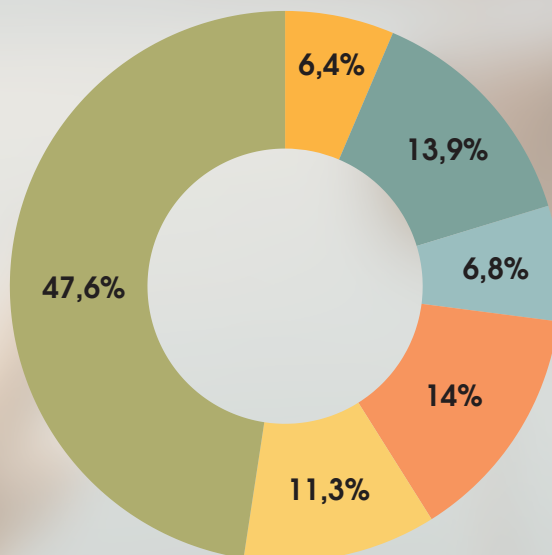

# July in Lviv

## Rehabilitation and Prosthetics Center "Superhumans Center"

On July 14th, children visited the Superhumans Center for the second time. The participants of the SviTy project learned about prosthetics and accessibility, they were genuinely interested in becoming rehabilitation doctors, and had the opportunity to interact with our Heroes. The children tried walking with the training prosthetics and used wheelchairs, everyone got to realise how challenging it can be. It's worth noting the warm and friendly atmosphere at the Center - the SviTy kids felt comfortable, had the opportunity to ask questions, and even had some fun, for example, participating in wheelchair races.



Such visits are extremely important for the acceptance of people with prosthetics. A big thank you to the Superhumans team for the invitation and your work, you are doing God's work!



# July in Lviv

## Camp in the Carpathians, 2nd session, July 19-26

Childhood should be filled with laughter, joy, and warm memories. The second rehabilitation camp in the Carpathians became an unforgettable adventure for each and every participant: team games, outdoor activities, evenings by the bonfire, conversations about the most important things, fun English lessons, contests, and tons of positive emotions. All this is crucial for psychological recovery. 26 teenagers from different cities of Ukraine took part in the second session.

## Camp in Cherkasy, 4th session

While the second group of teenagers was actively spending time in the Carpathians, the fourth session of the day camp started in the city. The unique program of this session included a picnic on the banks of the Dnipro River, where children, along with an ethnographer, learned about the traditions of the Kupala holiday and drew Trypillian symbols.



In addition, during the day camp, teenagers learned to cook pastries and a mint and lime drink. During the master class on Ukrainian traditions, they made a Zernovukh. They also had the opportunity to meet with scouts who shared with them many interesting things, taught them how to navigate by compass, and tie strong knots.



# July in Khmelnytskyi

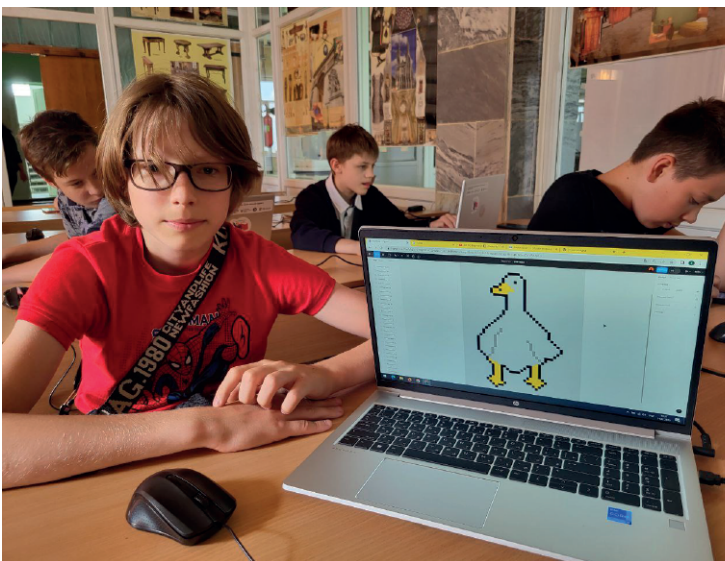
## Excursion to the Orlovsky Palace

## Poster-making master class

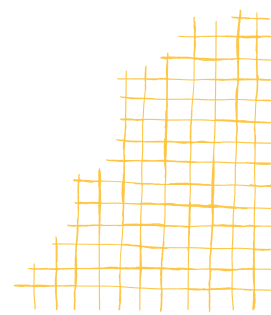
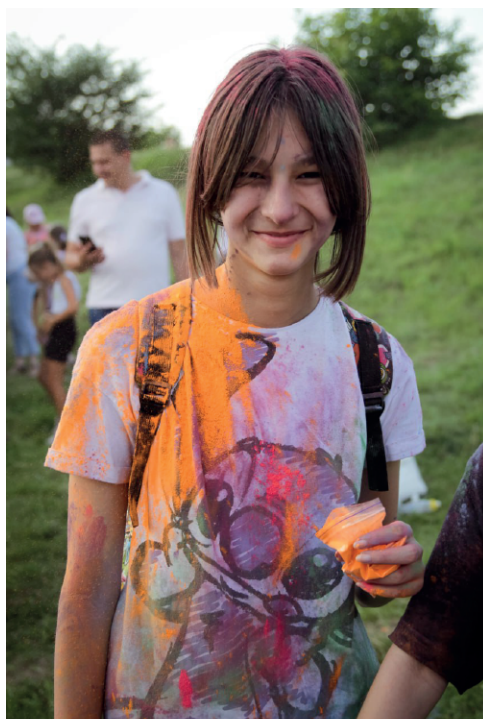

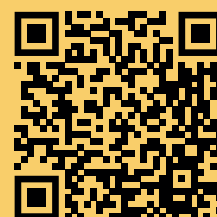
