

November in Lviv

Workshop "Media Literacy. Media Education"

At the Lviv club, a training session on "Media Literacy. Media Education" was conducted. It is important to discuss this topic, especially at a time when there is a lot of information, and it is necessary to know how to filter it. Participants gained a set of knowledge, skills, and abilities that allow them to understand, analyze, and critically evaluate the media, their stories, and articles.



Conflict Resolution Workshop

In November, a training session on "What are conflicts and how to resolve them" took place. Children discussed the concept of "conflict," learned about the different types of conflicts, whether there are positive aspects to them, and how to resolve them. This topic is relevant for everyone, and the knowledge gained will be useful in life.

November in Cherkasy

Children observed the rehearsal process right from the stage, learned about the many complex mechanisms involved in each process, peeked into the orchestra pit, went up to the third tier, and learned many interesting things from the costume designers. It was a truly unique and exciting experience for teenagers.



November in Khmelnytskyi

Masterclass "Monster from Plasticine"

Children participated in a creative masterclass where they created their own unique monsters from plasticine using the necessary materials. The main thing was that there were no limitations, so everyone could embody any idea and unleash their imagination.

Teens had a unique opportunity to immerse themselves in the atmosphere of American Thanksgiving Day together with American guest Met.
