
Musical Event "Family Jam"

Animation Workshop

Park Quest

"SviTy" participants embarked on a park quest, dividing into two teams, completing tasks to meet new people, then to enhance communicative skills: taking photos with challenges like capturing a person in white sneakers or glasses, capturing people holding hands, and more. Subsequently, they had to form a phrase from letters, decipher the location of the next task, find treasures in the form of treats using a compass and secret marks left by the hosts. It was a fantastic day!

Entertainment Center Visit

Finally, a visit to an entertainment center was made, where children started with a game of "tag" at the entrance. The lively atmosphere and enthusiasm for the game prompted children to scatter across the entire play area – some bounced on trampolines, others hung upside down on ropes, and some slid down slides into pools of colorful balls. Teenagers couldn't tear themselves away from the active games and were extremely happy to spend time together.






March in Zhytomyr
