

June in Lviv

The dramatized excursion at the Franko's House "A visit to Franko's family"

Adolescents had the opportunity to delve deeper into the renowned writer Ivan Franko. They embarked on a dramatized tour and listened to stories "from the horse's mouth" – from Ivan Franko and his wife Olha, immersing themselves in the past century and hearing tales of family life. Participants witnessed the household where the family lived and relaxed, had the chance to touch their personal belongings preserved to this day, and sensed the atmosphere of those times. The excursion facilitated a better understanding of Ivan Franko's creative journey, his ideas, and values that have left a profound mark on Ukrainian culture.

On June 22, we visited the "Safety Celebration" quest organized by representatives of the Cherkasy Institute of Fire Safety. Participants tackled various tasks under the supervision of experienced trainers and institute cadets: they "eliminated" chemical hazards, climbed ladders to the second floor, and some even to the third, observed a first aid masterclass, and practiced on mannequins. Next was mine clearance: donning special suits, protective masks, and using metal detectors, they attempted to find mines. Finally, there was a relay race involving a real fire hydrant. Everyone coped splendidly!
