April in Lviv

Traditions that Give Strength: Preparing for Easter

In April, a series of Easter workshops took place for children and their parents. During these meetings, participants immersed themselves in the atmosphere of the holiday, learned about Ukrainian traditions, and together created Easter decorations. Parents actively participated in the creative process — joint work became an opportunity for sincere communication, exchange of family stories, and strengthening family bonds. Such meetings are not just about creativity. They are about support, shared values, and preserving traditions that give strength today.



Therapeutic Meeting with Horses

In April, teenagers had the opportunity to visit a location with horses — animals that can bring peace and restore inner balance. Interacting with horses was not just a new experience, but also a form of emotional therapy. Children noted that being with these animals made it easier to relax, calm down, and feel harmony. This was an important moment of support that helped them better understand themselves and establish a connection with nature.



April in Cherkasy

Pysanky as a Symbol of Unity

Participants of the club hand-painted 25 pysanky, each of which represents the style of one of Ukraine's regions. Before the creative part, there was an educational lecture during which teenagers learned about the symbolism of Ukrainian pysanky, traditional ornaments, the meaning of colors and forms in different parts of the country. During the master class, children painted wooden eggs in their own style, respecting regional traditions. Each work is a piece of Ukraine, unity that teenagers embodied through art.



Easter Party: Family Atmosphere and Warmth of Traditions

This year's Easter party became a special event for children and teenagers — atmospheric, warm, and truly family-like. Participants immersed themselves in holiday traditions: creating Easter crafts, participating in contests and fun games, sharing memories, laughing a lot, and enjoying delicious pastries. In every moment — sincerity, support, and a sense of community. Such meetings remind us: the most important thing is to have those around you with whom you feel unity and care. This is what gives strength.



April in Khmelnytskyi

Ebru: A New Experience through Art

Teenagers tried their hand at ebru — painting on water. This process genuinely captivated them, as it allows for the creation of unique patterns without limitations. The lesson became a space for self-expression, reducing emotional stress, and discovering their creative potential. The paintings turned out to be bright, emotional, and truly unique.



Denim Party: Creativity, Teamwork, and Cake

At the end of April, a denim party took place at "Svity" — a day of getting to know each other, teamwork, and creativity. The celebration began with a story about the history of jeans. Then participants formed four teams and received a task — to create a unique picture from old jeans, giving them a new life. The winning team received souvenirs, and all participants — a sweet bonus in the form of a thematic denim cake.



April in Zhytomyr

Gifts for the Military: Support that Builds Strength

In April, teenagers made gifts and souvenirs for the military in the hospital — an initiative that positively impacted both the recipients and the participants. Such activities help teenagers feel their importance and reduce stress through the creative process. Receiving sincere feedback from the military boosts self-esteem and confidence. This also forms a patriotic attitude — through letters of support, teenagers learn to appreciate defenders and convey their emotions through good deeds.



Master Class in Pysanka Painting

Teenagers in Zhytomyr also joined the traditional pysanka painting — an activity that combines creativity, learning, and the atmosphere of Easter calm. Participants delved into symbolism, experimented with colors and ornaments. For some, this was their first experience, for others — a beloved Easter ritual. But for all — an opportunity to feel peace, inspiration, and unity.

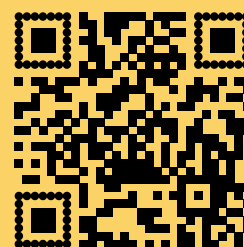
