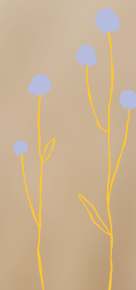

February in Lviv

Career Orientation Excursion to SoftServe

When teenagers gain access to new knowledge and opportunities, they begin to look more confidently towards their future. In February, participants of the "Svity" program visited the SoftServe office — one of the leading IT companies in Ukraine. During the tour, the children became familiar with the work of a modern IT team, saw how the work process is organized, and met with different IT specialties. Company professionals talked about current technologies, career opportunities in the IT field, and the importance of continuous development. Participants had the opportunity to ask questions and receive advice on professional choice.



Podcast Recording with a Personal Brand Mentor

Teenagers had a unique experience — they became real participants in the recording of a podcast with a personal brand mentor. The children did not just listen, but took an active part: they tried themselves in the role of hosts, asked questions, and immersed in the atmosphere of a real creative process. They discussed the important topic of personal branding: how to find oneself, where to start, how to make oneself known to the world, and be unique, not just "like everyone else." This experience inspires and helps teenagers better understand their strengths and potential.



February in Cherkasy

Valentine's Day Party

A Valentine's Day celebration took place at the club — a party filled with romance, laughter, and warmth. Teenagers learned about the history of the holiday during a quiz, participated in contests, and wrote valentines, which they left in a festive mailbox. Cupid delivered a personal prediction to each one, adding a touch of magic to the evening. The thematic photo zone, created by hand, became a place for bright photos and happy memories. The atmosphere was friendly and sincere — with laughter, and open hearts. Such moments stay with teenagers for a long time.



Sound Therapy

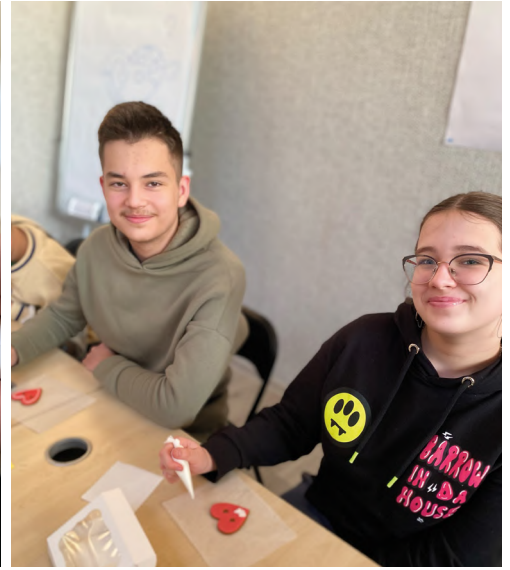
Sound therapy became a unique experience for teenagers, immersing them in the world of harmonious vibrations that calm, reduce stress, and help find inner balance. Participants became familiar with Tibetan bowls, gongs, bells, tried playing musical instruments, and sang songs together. Sound waves promoted deep relaxation, concentration, and improved emotional state. Teenagers felt lightness, peace, and a charge of energy. Sound therapy demonstrated its effectiveness as a soft tool for emotional support for children.



February in Khmelnytskyi

Master Class "Decorating Cookies"

For Valentine's Day, a master class in decorating gingerbread hearts was organized — children created their own sweet gifts with wishes. While the icing dried, participants wrote sincere words, which they later attached with ribbons to their creations. The final stage was packaging in gift boxes — each took home not only a beautifully decorated souvenir, but also a piece of the holiday created with their own hands. This was a day of warmth, creativity, and kind words — exactly what every child needs.



Pajama Party

On the last day of winter, February 28, a cozy pajama party for teenagers took place at the "Svity" club. In a relaxed atmosphere, they talked about school, friends, and everyday life, completed team tasks, and simply relaxed. The highlight of the evening was a photo session with a professional photographer — a reminder of warm moments and sincere smiles.



February in Zhytomyr

Training "Friendship, Love, Relationships"

Teenagers discussed relationships, understanding important concepts such as love and friendship. They talked about what distinguishes true love from fleeting infatuations, and also understood that friendship is based on trust, respect, and support. Particularly interesting were the exercises where participants described their ideal friend and loved one. This helped them realize what qualities they value in people, and as a result, each understood what aspects are important in relationships: honesty, support, common interests, and the ability to compromise.



Training with a Psychologist "Happiness House"

What makes a home a place where you want to return? During a training session with psychologist Alla Bunis at the Youth Space Ko Laba, teenagers created their "Happiness Houses." They cut, glued, colored, and at the same time discussed important questions: what true peace means, how to build emotional comfort around oneself, and how to appreciate family warmth. Each house became a symbol of the inner world of the participants and a reminder that happiness can be built even from the smallest details.

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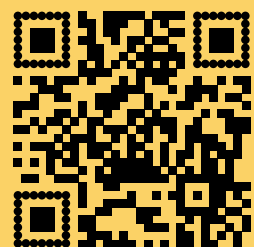
