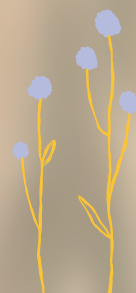

# March in Lviv

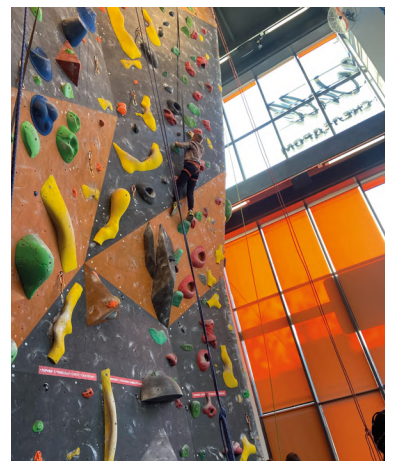
## Completion of the Workshop Series within the Mentorship Program

We completed a series of workshops for teenagers, and this was truly an interesting journey of self-awareness, development, and change. Seven meetings provided a wealth of insights and many practical skills. Teenagers explored how their environment influences their decisions, understood what is truly valuable to them, searched for their identity and mission, learned to set goals, manage time, and take responsibility for their lives. Each workshop was filled with interactive tasks, practices, and discussions that helped reinforce knowledge and immediately apply it in real life.



## Master Class in Rock Climbing

If the peak seems unattainable — just take the first step. And then another. And another. Rock climbing teaches the same as life: sometimes it's scary, sometimes it's hard, but every step upwards makes you stronger. Participants of the "Svity" program tested their strength on a rock climbing wall. This is not just a sports activity — it's about trusting yourself, overcoming fear, and discovering a new experience. Every step upwards is a small victory that boosts self-confidence. By conquering height, they learn to overcome internal barriers. Because the path to recovery is always a forward movement.



# March in Cherkasy

## Master Class "Living Forest"

During the master class, children worked with natural materials: stabilized moss, dried flowers, and other accessories made from natural raw materials. This format of eco-therapy is an opportunity to feel harmony and peace through contact with nature, even in a miniature format. Participants created their own compositions, which turned out to be sophisticated and diverse. Working with moss not only develops practical skills but also increases environmental awareness. The creative process helped with emotional relief, allowed them to escape from difficult circumstances, and opened up new possibilities for self-expression.



## Excursion to Kholodnyi Yar

The children made a journey to Kholodnyi Yar to see the real spring wonder — the blooming of snowdrops. Within the trip, they visited the Motronynskiy Monastery — a place with a deep history and special energy. Here, prominent historical figures once visited, and the participants of the journey could feel the spirit that has been preserved through the centuries. After a rich day, the group rested in a quiet pavilion near the Haydamatskyi Lake. Informal communication, jokes, and views created an atmosphere of tranquility and were the perfect ending to the journey.



# March in Khmelnytskyi

## Master Class in Podil Embroidery

Children had a wonderful opportunity to participate in an event where they learned about Podil embroidery and its elements used in everyday life. They tried to create their own ornament and saw that it is not at all difficult. The drawings turned out to be bright and unique, and each could feel how creativity and traditions merge in unique works.



## Museum of Curious Science "Eureka"

The "Svity" participants visited the Museum of Curious Science "Eureka." They were greeted by exhibits on anatomy, illusions, puzzles, mirror and laser mazes, an acoustic room, and much more. The uniqueness of the museum is its interactivity: each exhibit could be studied, touched, and experienced firsthand. This was not just a tour, but an exciting experience that combines science and fun. They returned with a bundle of positive emotions and a charge of good mood!



# March in Zhytomyr

## Ceremony "Initiation of Svity Members"

The initiation into the Svity club is a bright emotional moment filled with excitement, pride, and inspiration. Children feel that they are becoming part of something bigger, finding their place in a community of peers who share their ideas and values. Excitement and joy intertwine with a slight nervousness — this is a new stage in their lives. For many, this moment symbolizes the recognition of their efforts, determination, and desire to participate in significant matters. This inspires new achievements and boosts confidence. Additionally, such an event promotes friendship — shared experiences create a strong bond between teenagers. The initiation leaves warm memories and strengthens the sense of unity.



## Excursion "Polissian House"

The trip to the "Polissian House" was a real journey through time. Teenagers learned how Polissian families lived more than 120 years ago, what traditions and daily habits they had. But the adventure did not end there. Participants became the heroes of a quest with acting transformations, felt the thrill on the tubing hill, and tasted the legendary smikhuny pancakes. Such trips are not just a break, but an opportunity to find friends, broaden their horizons, and feel their culture more deeply.
